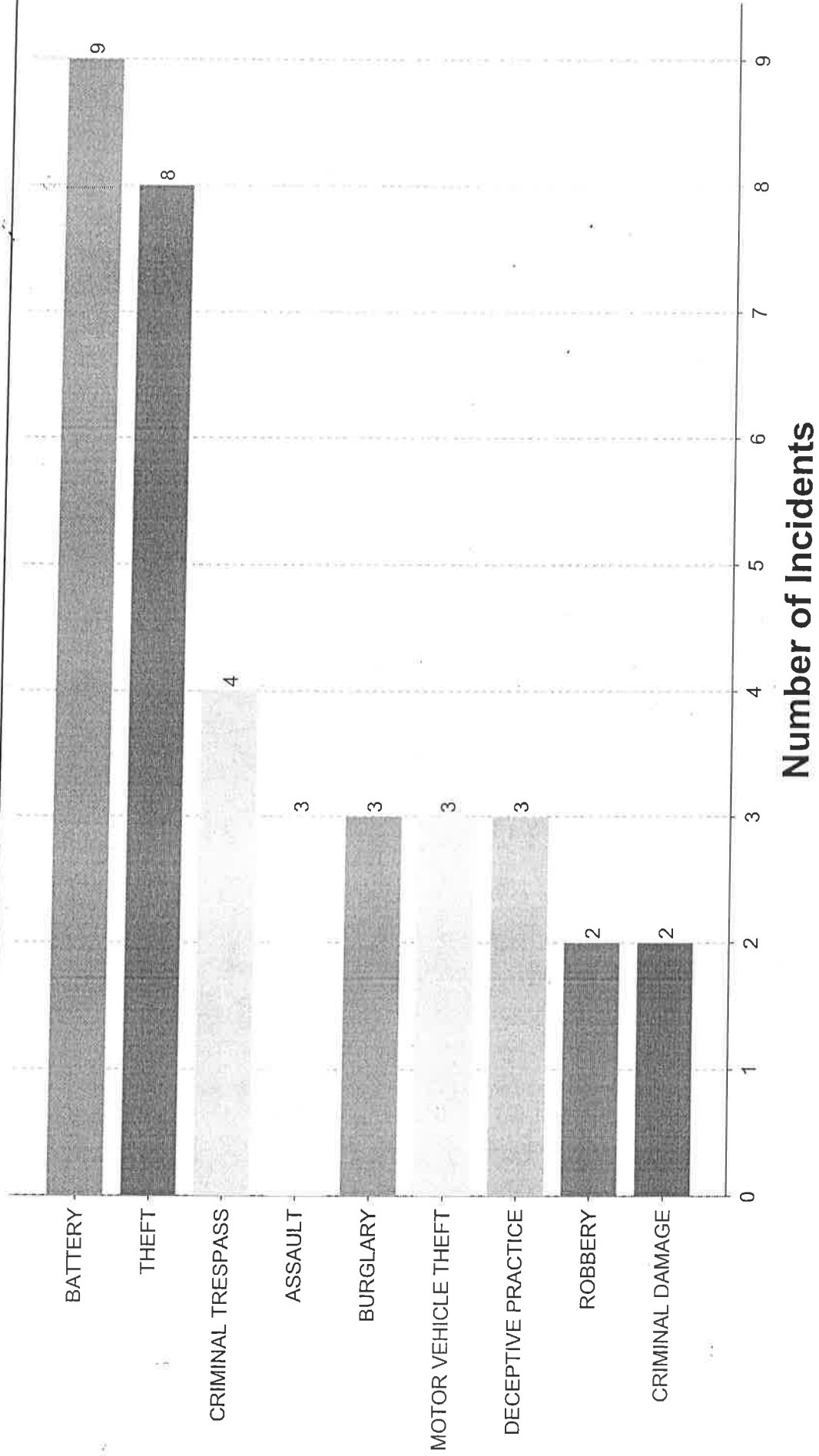

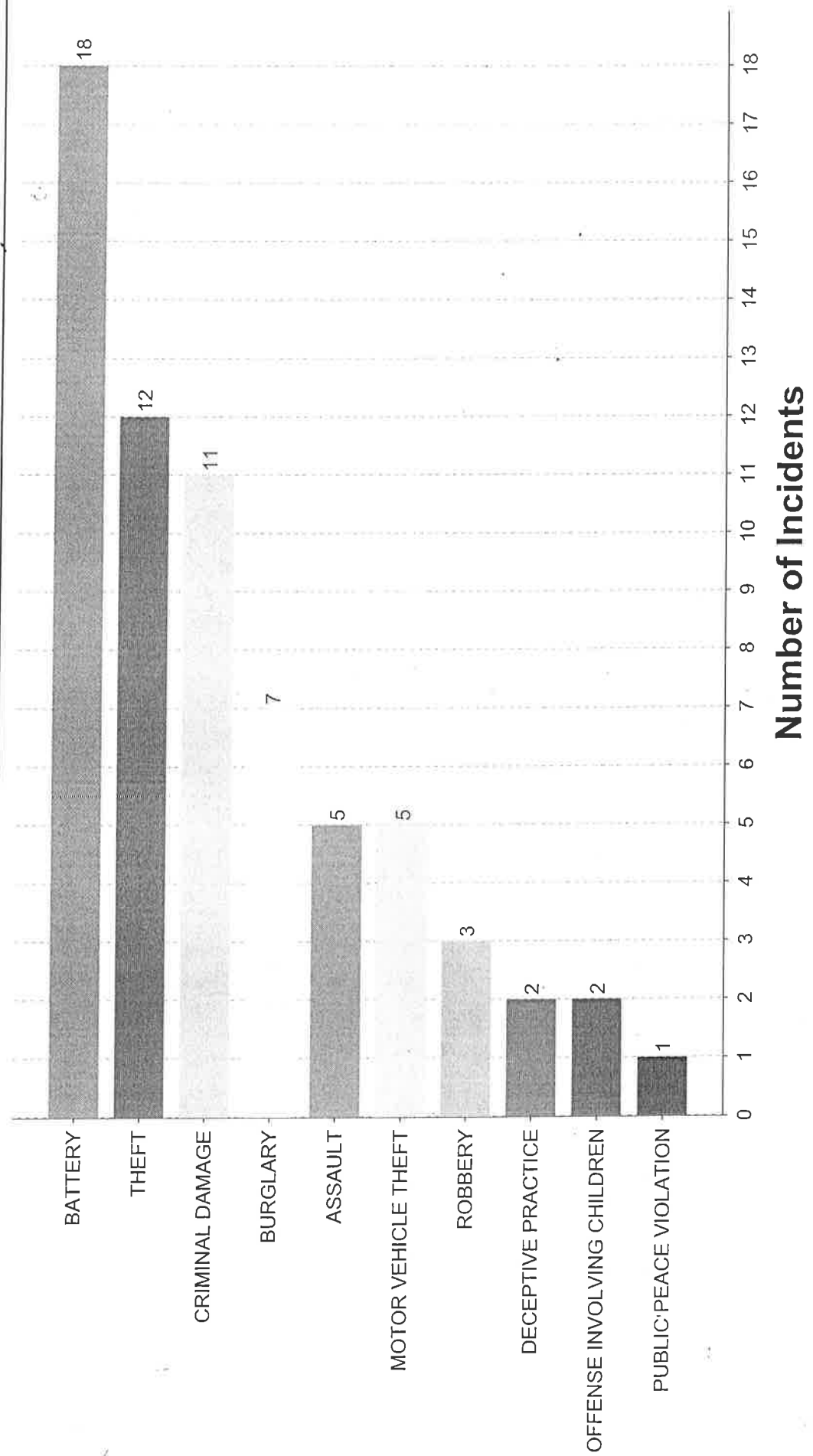

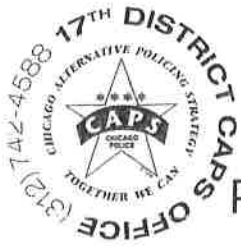

When Using Public Transportation:

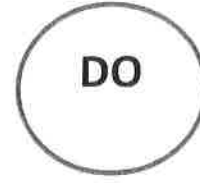

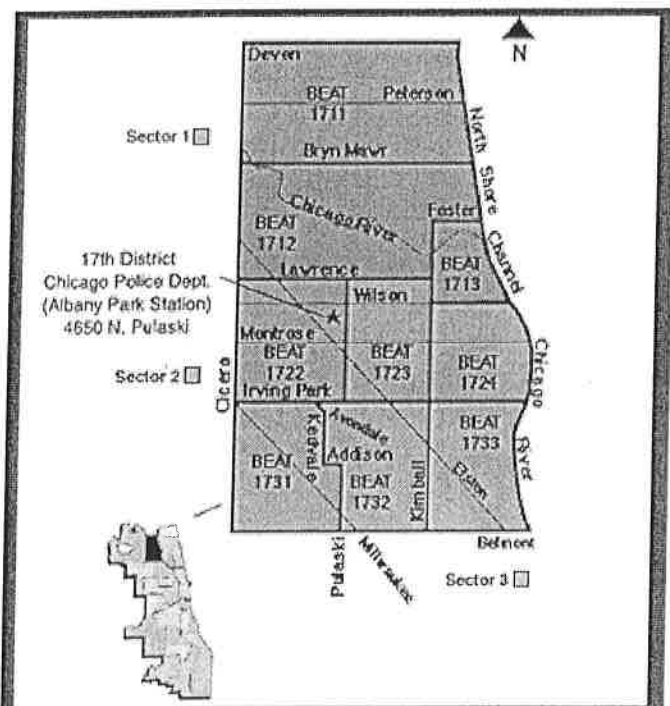
